better than poorly fitted ones. The right compression level (measured in mmHg) is essential for achieving the desired therapeutic effects. We'll help you choose the right level based on your needs.

Compression socks come in different pressure levels, measured in millimeters of mercury (mmHg), and various sizes to ensure a perfect fit and effectiveness. Here's a breakdown of the common compression levels and their uses:

- 15-20 mmHg
  - Uses: Mild compression, suitable for everyday wear, mild swelling, and mild varicose veins.
  - Who: Ideal for travelers, people who stand or sit for long periods, and those with mild circulation issues.
- 20-30 mmHg
  - Uses: Moderate compression, used for moderate varicose veins, moderate edema, and postsurgical recovery.
  - Who: Commonly recommended for people with more pronounced circulation issues, athletes, and post-operative patients.
- 30-40 mmHg
  - Uses: Firm compression, for severe varicose veins, severe edema, and prevention of DVT.
  - Who: Typically prescribed for severe medical conditions and must be used under medical supervision.
- 40-50 mmHg
  - Uses: Extra firm compression, for severe venous insufficiency and severe lymphedema.
  - Who: Usually recommended by a healthcare provider for specific medical conditions.

Our staff will measure your calf circumference and leg length to find the perfect size for you. If you wear compression socks daily, it's a good idea to have multiple pairs. This allows each pair to rest and regain their elasticity between uses. Regularly check your socks for signs of wear and tear. If they start to lose their elasticity or show holes, it's time to replace them.
